### Language Arts:

- Reading
  - upper + lowercase
  - letter sounds for consonants + short vowels
  - know letters are linked together to form sounds
  - Blend short sequence of phonemes to form words "c-at"
  - Syllables
  - CVC, VCC, CVC, CCVC word review
  - know how to read + write name
  - Age appropriate sight words.
  - Order story sequencing for stories

### math: Patterns + Classifications:

- Group objects into sets
- Identify + continue simple repeating patterns
- Numbers + Number Theory
  - Count from 1-31
  - Understand 1-to-1 correspondance: count objects then write # down
  - Know first - fifth
  - Given a # know one more or one less.
  - Understand  $\frac{1}{2}$
- Operations:
  - Add + subtract 1-10
  - Know meaning of (+) plus + (-) minus
  - Invent and solve simple story problems
  - make + interpret simple pictorial graphs

### money + measurements

- penny, nickel, dime, quarters, dollar bills, dollar + cents signs
- experiment w/ measurements of length, width, weight + capacity.

## • money + measurements continued:

- thermometer + what it measures, be able to make simple hotter than/colder than comparisons.
- compare lengths of time it takes to complete something  
\* longer to do this? or that?
- Tell time to the hour
- Knows days of week + months.

- know right/left, closed/open, under/over, in front/in back, above/below
- recognize shapes
